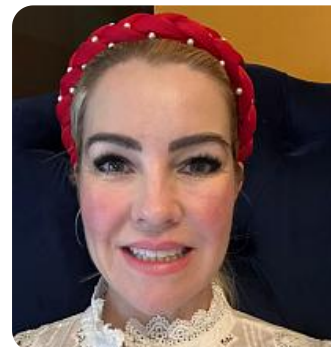

This long-term position included supervision for three children (aged 3 months, 3 and 11 years old boys at the start of employment). The main focus was tutoring Key Stage 3 English, mathematics and science for the 11+ exams. When the two older children were in school, she provided routine creation, sleep training, weaning, meal preparation and developmental activities for the infant. A mixture of sole charge and shared care. Live-in position.

In the last 6 months, of this position, she worked for other relatives of the family,

there she was a personal tutor to two boys (aged 8 and 10) with focus on English and mathematics (at Key Stage 2 level), but also a range of other subjects for 11+ exams. I was also a house manager for the estate, including organising staff schedules; recruitment and training of staff; liaising with third parties in any maintenance; refurbishment of house/vehicles; travel and visa arrangements for the family; event arrangements and general diary management; and care of 3 large dogs. Live-out position, but worked long hours.
