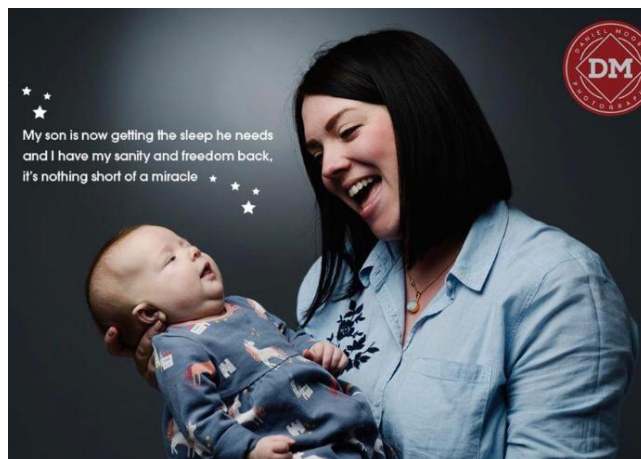

- I have spent the last 6 years working with families directly in the home. My role includes

- This was an exciting and challenging time, where I spent almost 3 years living and working in Vietnam. My main role was as an English teacher although this expanded into a number of different areas, including charities and hospitality sector, where I would teach local hotel staff the relevant language skills to enable them to provide an excellent level of service to holiday makers.

December 2012 - June 2013

Level 1 adult pre-employment English / IT course leader

My role includes

- I worked with the Job Centre Plus (JCP) as tutor, manager and course constructor to build this four week short course for disengaged unemployed adults. I recognised a gap in the offer within colleges and felt that funding was standing in the way of Preemployed adults coming off benefits and progressing into employment. Whilst teaching on this course I made it the focus of my PGCE dissertation and have interesting findings about 'Motivating preemployed adults to succeed.' The drive behind this course was on learners returning to work after periods of unemployment. The course provided a vocational path heavily rooted in English and IT improvement, with a specific end incentive (FLT/CSCS/Driving lessons).

September - December 2012

English Functional Skills tutor

My role includes

- During this time I taught entry 2 – level 1 spelling and grammar on both the functional skills for adults and Pathways to Employment summer course for 1419 year olds. This involved a mixture of learning and teaching styles, an active approach to English through a variety of topics and differentiated teaching styles. This course has an emphasis on health and safety, interview preparation and many other relevant topics to aid in learners in their life journey.
